RUSPIDGE WELFARE TRUST

Council were mindful that these items were considered and determined as trustees to the RWT.

- 1. Members' noted the 2014 Annual Return submission figures to the Charity Commission.
- 2. Members' AGREED that the Parish Clerk will submit online future Annual Returns.
- 3. Members' were advised of the signatories (HH/BH/SRP two to sign).
- 4. Members' unanimously APPROVED the request from the Ruspidge Playgroup to use the land to the rear of the Memorial Hall for an eco/nature reserve area for the children. The Playgroup were advised to submit a grant application to the council and to check its insurance cover.

THE PRESENT CHAIRMAN PRESIDED OVER THE MEETING UNTIL THE NEW CHAIRMAN WAS ELECTED.

Public Participation

- <u>Soudley and Blakeney Gateway</u> Awre councillor Andy Blake suggested that signage of the trail would be required once the link is completed and would welcome both council's liaising regarding this and future maintenance of the trail. The chairman advised that this council would like to see a long term maintenance plan before any decisions were made. It was also understood that there were no Soudley representatives on the Gateway Committee. Further investigations will be made to the committee to determine exactly what they need.
- 2. <u>Buckshaft Road, speeding</u> Mr. Hardcastle advised that the Police are monitoring the traffic speed. After the council has co-opted new members the Police Commissioner will be invited to attend a future parish meeting.
- 5. <u>Election of the Chairman</u> Cllr. Hawkins proposed Cllr. Stanford be nominated as Chairman. This was seconded by Cllr. Phelps and **AGREED** unanimously by Council. Cllr. Stanford duly signed the declaration of office.

5.6 MATTERS ARISING

Buckshaft Road Footpath - awaiting Highways response.

<u>Football Pitch</u> - Sportfields gave consent for the recent cut and a meeting has been arranged with interested clubs and the groundsman for the 19th May.

First Aid Course - was well attended, enjoyable and a success.

Emergency Plans - in progress. Date for completion - November meeting.

<u>Flood Resilience</u> - Cllr. Phelps reported and a map from the Env. Agency showing possible areas at risk of flooding was tabled. Updates will be reported accordingly.

<u>Pet Ambulances</u> - the Street Wardens had been notified of the ambulances blocking the junction and pavements at Cullimore View and Railway Road. Council were advised that the situation has improved.

<u>Litter, Grange Road</u> - a further request had been received for a litter sign to be placed beneath the national speed limit sign. Council **DECLINED** the request determining that a sign would not solve the litter problem.

- 5.7 The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 14th April, 2015, were **ACCEPTED** as a true record of the meeting and were signed by the Chairman.
- 5.8 There were no matters arising from these minutes.
- 5.9 The Parish Council Chairman's Report and Ruspidge Welfare Trust's Report had been received at the April meeting and there was nothing further to discuss.

- 5.15. The Clerk/ Responsible Financial Officer, circulated the Annual Financial Report.
- 5.16 <u>Internal Audit</u> Members' received a signed statement from Mrs. Fowler, reporting her considerations of the Council's accounts for the year ending 31st March, 2014. Mrs. Fowler confirmed that no irregularities had been found and thereby confirming the correctness of the accounts had duly signed the Annual Audit Return.
- 5.17 In accordance with the Audit Regulations the Clerk, as the RFO, tabled the Annual Audit Return for the year ended 31st March, 2015. Following explanation the Council **APPROVED** the Statement of Accounts and the Annual Governance Statement, for receipt by the external auditors on 8th June, 2015. The Chairman and Clerk signing the relevant sections.
- 5.18 <u>Co-option Timescale</u> Council determined the 30th June, 2015 as the deadline for applications, with all candidates being invited to the July meeting. Notices will be placed on the parish notice boards, in the *Viewpoint*, on *facebook* and in the Review paper.
