Public Participation

- 1. <u>Leylandii Trees, Ruspidge Industrial Site</u> Concern was raised that the Leylandii are extensively overgrown, blocking out light and leaning towards the residential houses. The council confirmed it will contact the owner of the site to arrange a site visit and discuss how to rectify the problem.
- 2. Ruspidge Chip Shop, Parking There was concern about the number of customers who are parking their cars along the length of road by the chip shop and the nearby area, causing congestion and access difficulties for other road users. The council noted the comments.
- 7. **MINUTES** The Minutes of the Council meeting held on the 9th June, 2015 were **ACCEPTED** as a true record of the meeting and were signed by the Chairman.
- 7.1 **MATTERS ARISING** from the Minutes.

Hedge Letters, Buckshaft Road - The clerk confirmed that the letters have been issued.

<u>Japanese Knotweed</u> - There had been no reply, to date, from the FODDC.

Notice Boards - The boards have been re-coated.

Buckshaft Pavement - Awaiting Highways approval.

<u>Soudley and Blakeney Gateway</u> - Cllr. Stanford attended the committee meeting but advised that there is a lack of officers and, at present, there is no management plan for the maintenance of the trail.

<u>Woodland View Play Area</u> - Cllr. Stanford and the clerk met with Chris Snell of Greenfields upon which it was agreed to go ahead with the works as per Greenfields report. The lead date for the works will be September. The clerk will also arrange for the play area equipment to be painted in bright colours once all works have been carried out.

<u>Football Field</u> - Cllrs. Stanford, Hawkins and Paul Gibson (groundsman) will meet with Sportfields tomorrow (15th July). An update will follow.

<u>Code of Conduct</u> - Cllr. Hedges attended the workshop and gave a brief report. A full report will be forwarded by email for circulation to members.

- Soudley road markings should be completed by the end of August.

- 7.5 Following report by the Treasurer the Council **APPROVED** the accounts presented for payment totalling £3,825.55, this figure being inclusive of the expenditure recorded under confidential business.
- 7.6 <u>Income and Expenditure Sheets</u> Members' received the entries for the first quarter.
- 7.7 <u>FODDC Street Cleaning Service Level Agreement</u> Council **RESOLVED** to ACCEPT the Service Level Agreement which was duly signed by Cllr. Stanford and the clerk. A schedule of works will be requested from the parish street cleaner.
- 7.8 <u>Dog Bin Request</u> Members' having considered the request for a dog bin at the gates from Coombe Drive to St. White's Road, determined to ask the St. Warden to investigate further before any decision would be made to provide a bin.
- 7.8 <u>Soudley Village Field, Litter Bin</u> The clerk advised council that two redundant oval bins had been supplied free of charge by the FODDC.
- 7.9 Old Email Address Council **RESOLVED** that the old address (rspc.aic.co.uk) can now be deactivated. The Clerk will notify the supplier.
- 7.10 <u>Facebook</u> Council **RESOLVED** that local charity events can be advertised on the council facebook page but not regular groups/clubs/activities eg., Zumba, Tae Kwan Do, Bingo, etc.
- 7.11 Flood Action Group The Parish Council is in the process of drawing up Emergency Action Plans for the parish and flooding will be one of the eventualities considered. Council, therefore, **RESOLVED** that there would be no need to have a specific rep to join the flood group. However, if any councillor had an interest in attending the group's meetings they could do so on a personal level.
