RUSPIDGE WELFARE TRUST

- 1.1 **MATTERS ARISING** from the Minutes.
 - <u>PCC Road Safety Scheme</u> Cllr. Richardson updated the council on the Vehicle Activated Signs (VAS) project. Further progress cannot be made until St. Lighting confirm the suitability of the lamp posts and also provide implementation costs. An agreement is to be reached on how to manage the VAS.
- 1.2 <u>Parish Council Casual Vacancy</u> the council will inform the FODDC of the vacancy. Unless ten registered electors request an election the council will fill the vacancy by co-option. The parish council is under-represented by females and would welcome female applications.

- Budget process meeting in February increase in green bin fees.
