4.3 **COUNTY COUNCILLOR REPORT**

- £150million extra available for roads of Gloucestershire over 3-4 years.
- Potholes repaired in low temperatures are done for safety and will need to be re-repaired when the weather allows.
- A417 missing link progressing.
- Public Rights of Way now under GCC, not Amey.
- Forest of Dean County Cllrs., have £30,000 each over 3 years to spend on suitable projects within their wards. With 9 County Cllrs., in the Forest of Dean this equates to £270, 000, that can be spend within the area.
- GCC are holding a photographic competition of landscapes.
 The winning photographs will be displayed in the Archives office.
- The Lengthsman scheme starts in May.
