Standing Declarations of Interest

- (a) Ruspidge Memorial Hall Insignificant personal interest by Cllrs. Matthews & Snell.
- (b) FODDC Planning Committee Cllr. Packer will withdraw from the parish meeting whilst the planning applications are discussed.

Police Report – PCSO Nick Jones advised of 35 incidents in the Parish, September to October. 6 crimes: 2 assaults; 2 malicious; 1 stalking; 1 drugs. There were 2 road traffic collisions, no injuries.

Public Participation

1. Concern was raised regarding the St. White's old school site, and the lack of progress. Council explained that the site owners', Gloucestershire County Council, had put the site up for sale for residential development. The Parish Council being very concerned about the junction lobbied GCC to make the junction wider and that these works be carried out prior to any development. Consequently, GCC made it a condition that the prospective developer covers the costs of widening the junction. This was actioned and GCC awaited a developer who was willing to purchase with this condition. Council advised that this is the one and only chance for the junction to be improved and it is imperative that all options are considered to get the best possible improvement. The current application will be discussed under agenda item 10.4.

RUSPIDGE WELFARE TRUST

Members' were mindful that these items were considered and determined as trustees to the RWT.
