


Do not disturb the feral wild boar

living in the forest



Please do not feed, or leave food for, the wild boar. They learn to associate people with food and then may become aggressive to visitors. Sows with piglets are more likely to react to strangers.

They are well adapted to living and feeding in their own environment. If you leave the boar alone they will ignore you. This includes keeping your dog on a lead whenever you see them.



What to do if you see wild boar:

- 1. Do not approach them. Go back the way you came or go around them giving a wide berth.
- 2. Avoid walking through dense woodland.

 These are their safe resting and breeding areas.
- Put your dog on a lead as soon as you see one or they may get scared and react.
- **4. Keep to a safe distance.** Particularly if your dog chases or does not respond to calls immediately.
